INTRODUCTION

The **MX-3004F 3G/HD/SD-SDI Quad-view Video Processor** is an advanced video processor for multimedia presentations. It is an ideal solution for some application such as broadcasting, where up to four SDI video signals must be displayed on a single display. It supports up to 4 SDI video inputs, of which four can be outputted simultaneously with the desired display layout through software control, IR remote or front panel. The advanced video processor allows you to manipulate output images, wherever positions and whatever sizes you want for viewing four computers or four video signals or a combination.

The embedded processor converts signals from input sources to match the native resolution of monitors, flat panel displays, projectors as well as user-selectable output settings up to WUXGA (1920x1200). Dual outputs are provided in both digital (SDI) and digital (DVI) format, one is connected to remote display and other is connected to on-site display for real time monitoring.


PANEL DESCRIPTIONS

Front Panel



1. **Output Resolution Button:** Select output resolution
2. **Label Button:** Window's label ON/OFF
3. **Custom Layout 1-8:** Save custom layout button
4. **IR Sensor:** IR sensor for receiving the IR commands from IR remote
5. **Default Layout mode A:** Select default layout () or custom layout
6. **Default Layout mode B:** Select default layout ( ,  ,  , )
7. **Input 1-4 Select Button:** Select input source

8. **Power Switch:** Power On/Off
9. **RS-232:** RS-232 control port
10. **+12V DC:** Connect to the +12VDC power supply unit.
11. **Dip Switch:** Switch the firmware update mode or factory reset mode (Switch ON)
12. **Device ID:** To identify between units
13. **Mini-USB:** For firmware update
14. **Ethernet:** Ethernet control port.
15. **Outputs:** 2 SDI outputs
16. **Outputs:** DVI output
17. **Input 1-4:** SDI inputs 1-4
18. **SDI local loop out**

HARDWARE INSTALLATION

Safety Precautions

1. To prevent fire or shock hazards, do not expose this device to rain or moisture.
2. The product should be placed more than one foot away from heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, and other products (including amplifiers) that produce heat. In addition, do not cover any material or devices on the top of the device.
3. Do not use immediately after moving from a low temperature to high temperature, as this causes condensation.
4. Do not place this product on an unstable cart, stand, or table. The product may fall, causing serious injury to a child or adult and serious damage to the product.
5. Unplug this product from the wall outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners. Use a damp cloth for cleaning.
6. Do not allow the same still picture to be projected for a long time or an abnormally bright video picture to be projected. The video image could be burned in to the display device.

Installation Procedures

Unpacking

Remove the MX-3004F from the shipping container and examine it for any signs of shipping damage or missing items (check with package contents above). All shipping items should be saved if the product is to be moved or returned for service. Shipping unit back to dealers for service not in the original box may result in voiding warranty or additional cost.

Placement

The unit uses convection to cool. A fan is not needed, so do not block the sides of this device or stack another device on the top or bottom of the MX-3004F.


Connections

We recommend the highest quality cables for both input and output connections.

1. Switch off the MX-3004F and all devices that you want to connect.
2. Connect a monitor, a projector or other displays that comes with DVI / SDI inputs
3. Connect a device equipped with SDI output including SD/HD/3G to the BNC input connector of MX-3004F.
4. Connect your computer with the MX-3004F by a 9-pin RS-232 cable or Cat.5e cable, and then install the software.
5. Plug in AD power cord into AC power socket.
6. Execute the control software and establish the connection between PC/Laptop and MX-3004F.
7. For detailed software control operation, please refer to the software instruction section.


CONNECTION DIAGRAM

Method B: Software Control through RS-232 port / Ethernet port


System Requirement and Precautions

1. The device provides a software control program, Quartet, which runs under Microsoft Windows 98, 2000, XP, Vista or 7 through the interface of RS-232 serial control.
2. Before you click the icon of the software, make sure you have secured the connection between your computer COM port and the device and switched on the device with green LED light.

Start the Operation Software

When you double-click the .exe file, the below dialog will pop-up. Connect the software via RS-232 or TCP/IP.

*under Microsoft Windows 7, please right click the program icon to start up as an administrator




RS-232 mode: Use RS-232 to connect the port on device and computer. Select correct serial COM port (Port Number) and click the Connect button.

Ethernet (TCP/IP) mode: Enter the device IP address and click the Connect button.

After the software control setting is completed, it will enter directly to control interface.





Display and adjust the window size and position.

2. Tool Bar list:




- (1)  Status: Get all information of the device and update this software state.

- (3)  Advance Setting: Set the no signal color, fade in/out effect, background picture, window text, input text, OSD border, Clock, audio and factory reset.




➤ Clock and Audio:

Click the  button to do factory default reset. This default reset process will take about 10~15 seconds and it will be initialized all setting to original system state.






Set the output resolution. When setting the different resolution, the parameters of PAP and custom layout (position and size) will change accordingly.


