



- 1. Power LED: Lights on when device is ready
- 2. Micro-USB Port: Connect to 5V DC power supply unit
- 3. EDID MODE:


*Automatic EDID learning will detect all the connected HDMI equipped monitors and analyze all the content of EDID. The EDID with maximal resolution support will be the reference EDID for incoming HDMI source players.

HARDWARE INSTALLATION

Broadcasts HDMI signal to 2 HDMI displays!

- 1. Switch off all devices, including monitors.
- 2. Connect to the displays.
- 3. Connect an HDMI source (such as a Blu-ray Disc player) to the HDMI In.
- 4. Plug in 5V DC power supply.
- 5. Power on the HDMI monitors.
- 6. Power on the HDMI source.

NOTICE

If somehow user cannot get video output, please try to adjust EDID dip switch to "[pin1, pin2] =[↑ - ↓]" or "[pin1, pin2]=[↓ - ↓]" for trouble shooting. Under "[pin1, pin2]=[↑ - ↓]", there will be video output. The only requirement is that the display has to support at least Full HD. If default Full-HD EDID still cannot work, user can switch to "[pin1, pin2]=[↓ - ↓]" to learn the EDID from output 1 to customize the EDID information. (Please note that the display with lowest resolution must be connected to output 1)

Select to [pin1, pin2]=[$\uparrow - \downarrow$] - Full-HD(1080p@60) – 12bit 3D video & 7.1ch audio

- 1) Set the rotary switch to "[pin1, pin2]=[$\uparrow \downarrow$]"
- 2) Power on the device

Select to [pin1, pin2]=[$\sqrt{-1}$] – Learning EDID from output 1

- 1) Set the dip switch to "[pin1, pin2]=[$\sqrt{-1}$]"
- 2) Power on the device
- 3) It will automatically learn EDID from output 1

[NOTE]

- a. If the user wants to change EDID mode, please power cycle the device after setting dip switch.
- 2. Firmware update is proceeded through Micro-USB.
 - 1) Save the firmware file (.bin) & software in the same folder.
 - 2) Connect the Micro-USB cable between PC and device
 - 3) Open firmware update software and then device will start to update firmware automatically.
 - 4) After update process is done, software will show "Success" message and then be closed automatically.
 - 5) Power cycle the device
